Horizon Foundation provides employment, job placement assistance and vocational training to several hundred people each year, including people with a disability and those needing extra help entering the workforce. Hundreds of job-seekers are assisted into employment through Horizon's job placement services: **Horizon Job Futures** and **Link Personnel**.

Horizon directly employs people with disabilities in their business services, offering meaningful work for a fair day's wage. Horizon's thriving businesses, **Wire & Wood Products** and **Marketforce Mailing & Finishing Services** are respected in the community for the quality of goods and services they provide, and for the caring supportive environment offered to employees.

Regardless of background or age, people facing barriers to employment can access certificate-level training through **Horizon Specialised Training**.
